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

OBSERVATIONS

Curricular Aspects: The division of academic and administrative responsibilities of the faculty is commendable. The college maintains the minutes of the staff meetings and committees' meetings. Course plans are prepared by the faculty and action plans are followed in ink and paper. A number of class tests and mid-term tests form the basis of student evaluation. Mechanism of evaluation of students Internal and external assessment is appreciable. There is a feedback system that helps the teachers in improving their performance. Intensive remedial teaching is also done for those who require academic support across the college. The students are also encouraged to participate in various inter-house curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities and have been awarded and recognized for the same. The workshops related to development of professional ethics, moral development, inculcation of human values, communication skills, and gender sensitization are conducted by the college to develop all round development of the students and to provide intensive knowledge to students.

Teaching Learning Aspects: The college follows student centric learning methods for effective curriculum delivery. OBSERVATIONS

Curricular Aspects: Academic calendar is prepared every year and same is also uploaded on college website and all activities (curricular and co-curricular) are planned keeping in view the academic calendar. Tests and assignments are incorporated with regular teaching learning process for the understanding of the topics. Students are kept engaged in competitions and assignment works. Regular meetings are held by the members of Curriculum development committee to discuss the issues related to mid-term course corrections, value added and self- development courses etc.

Teaching Learning Aspects: Teaching faculty of the form a strong backbone of teaching, learning, research, publication and overall academic and personality of the students. The college has well qualified and experienced teaching faculty. Apart from the academics the faculty members are also associated with social and cultural organisations. Their contribution in these fields is remarkable. In order to achieve academic excellence, the faculty members are committed and connected. The college management is supportive to the academic requirements of the teachers, students and staff members. The student-teacher ratio is appropriate. Innovative teaching techniques are used in teaching learning activities. All the faculty members are using ICT tools for effective teaching learning. Remedial classes are conducted for the students who need extra sessions in some difficult subjects. Assessment of learning levels after admission to identify slow and advanced learners is primarily done through internal assessments/assignments etc. done at the beginning of the academic session and well documented.

Various workshops and seminars (Awareness of Covid-19, Voter Awareness Day, Awareness of Yoga, Personality Development, Moral development) are organised by the college for the holistic development of the students. Slow and advanced learners are identified by conducting entry level examinations and learning experiences are provided according to their abilities.

Research, Innovation and Extension: Faculty members were exhorted to attend various Orientation and Refresher courses for their upgradation of knowledge and interactive session were held by those who came back to share recent knowledge and experiences they gained. Only Principal of the college Ph.D. degree. The college makes efforts to strengthen research work. The college provides duty leaves to faculty members to attend national and international seminars, workshops and conferences. The faculty members published books related to B.Ed. curriculum.

Infrastructure: The college has adequate infrastructure facilities for all academic activities. The college library provides teachers and students with necessary learning resources for effective delivery of curriculum. College library has subscription of research journals.

Students Support and Progression: The college organises various capacity building and skill enhancement activities for the students. Placement of the students and progression to higher

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education, though limited, are encouraging. Students need more encouragement for participation in extra-curricular activities.

Professional Development Activities: Teachers have participated in FDP's organised by other educational institutions and completed general orientation courses and refresher courses from various universities of India. The rest of the teachers should also regularly participate in FDPs, seminars, international conferences and workshops.

OBSERVATIONS

The College follow academic calendar for the effective planning of activities academic. Value added programmers are conducted by the college for the holistic development of the students. The strength of faculty members is appropriate as per the number of courses being run by the college. Faculty members are involved in the development of the curriculum. Regular meetings are held by the members of Curriculum development committee to discuss the issues related to mid-term course corrections, value added and self-development courses etc.

Teaching Learning Aspects: The college follows student centric learning methods for effective curriculum delivery. Various workshops (Yoga Practices, Personality development, and Communication Skills etc.) are organized by the college for the holistic development of the students. Report of the Academic and Administrative Audit

Academic and Administrative Audit 2020-21 held at Basaveshwar College of Education, Bidar, on 09th and 10th October 2018 by the External and Internal committee constituted by Basaveshwar College of Education, Bidar, and Governing Council (Management). Academic and Administrative Audit was conducted to examine and review the teaching-learning and administrative mechanisms of the institution. To monitor and enhance academic quality and standards which are necessary to achieve aims and objectives of the college, and to comment on the extent of effective implementation of procedures and reflect on best practices to maintain quality. The members of the Audit team investigated the different aspects of the Document presented before them, and authenticated them with the supporting evidences. The present report consolidates the findings of the Audit team and put forth the suggestions and area of improvements possible in the future.

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The following were the observations of the Audit team members

OBSERVATIONS

Curricular Aspects: For effective delivery of curriculum, the faculty members maintain the record of activities and progress of students. However, institutionalisation of this practice through planed manner will help in improvement of overall teaching and learning experiences. The construction of time table shows positive attitude towards the well-being of students as the commencement of first period was delayed by 20 minutes so that students can reach college without making any haste. The academic activities of the college are planned keeping in view the Programme Learning Outcomes and Course Learning Outcomes. There are two committees and cells in the college for the revision and development of the curriculum i.e., curriculum development cell and curriculum development committee.

Teaching Learning Aspects: With a view to make learning student centred, the institution always aims at overall personality development of the student teachers. The focus of all the activities in the teaching learning process is to produce effective and competent teachers as well as vigilant and valuable citizens. In order to achieve this objective, multiple mode approach to teaching learning is adopted by the institution. In regular classroom teaching, teachers utilize experiential learning, problem-solving methodologies, role-playing activities, brain storming, classroom seminars, group discussions, project work, assignment work, field visits and case studies for enhancing student learning. The college organise extension lectures, quiz periods, workshops, seminars, educational visits, field trips and other curricular and co-curricular competitions to enable the students to interact more closely with experts, accomplished academicians and research scholars from their own domain thereby broadening their world view beyond the realm of textbooks.

Research, Innovation and Extension: Teachers keeps assessment records as testimony. The number of research projects of the college is lacking.

Infrastructure: The college has adequate infrastructure facilities (computer lab, language lab, separate rooms for each teaching subject etc.) for all academic activities. The infrastructure is well maintained. Internet and library facility is provided to students, so that they can consult and refer the books to supplement their knowledge. The team also noted that books available in the college library are to an extent sufficient to pursue a comprehensive and meaningful research. The college needs to buy books from booksellers outside the country.

Students Support and Progression: The college organises various capacity building and skill enhancement activities for the students. Placement of the students and progression to higher education, though limited, are encouraging. Students need more encouragement for participation in extra-curricular activities.

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Professional Development Activities: The college has been maintaining academic exchange with other educational institutions. The faculty members of the college have been discharging services as External Experts and Subject Expert for Teachers/Faculty appointment in various Colleges and.

Weakness of the Institute:

- · Drinking water facility was found inadequate.
- Very few meetings of Alumni association were held.
- The contractual appointments have affected the dynamics of the professional growth of the teachers.
- Lack of laboratory demonstrators is another limitation in the academic front.
- Condition of college canteen was not appropriate.
- Funded research projects were lacked in the college.
- Skill development component was not mentioned in the college time-table.

Recommendations

Based on the findings, members of the audit committee recommend the following for enhancing the teaching-learning cosystem of the College:

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- Alumni activities should be made mandatory part of the college activities they should be
 actively engaged in every activity of the college, so that the college receives a higher visibility
 in the society.
- The staff should be encouraged to publish research work in reputed journals.
- The students should be oriented in details about the placements through college and their future prospects.
- The college should give emphasis on the publication, research funding and organization of national and international seminars.
