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REPORT ON MICRO-TEACHING ORIENTION AND DEMONSTRATION CLASSE 2022-2023

Objectives of the programme:

- Enable teacher trainees to learn and practicing new teaching skills under controlled conditions.
- To familiarize prospective teacher about the important of micro-teaching in instruction.
- To analyze the different components of micro-teaching skills and its application.
- To gain self-confidence among prospective teacher by scaling down all complexities of actual classroom situation.
- To make use of the academic potential of the teacher trainee by providing much needed feedback.
- To practice micro-teaching to develop core teaching skill for effective classroom teaching.
- To acquire the ability to integrate the micro teaching skills in normal classroom teaching.

HKES's Basaveshwar college of Education has organized a micro teaching orientation and demonstration classes from 01/03/2023 to 04/03/2023 for the first semester student.

Teacher – Educators has given orientation and demonstration pertaining to the importance of micro-teaching skills such as Skill of introduction, Skill of writing instructional objectives, Skill of explaining, Skill of probing questions, Skill of Fluency in Question, Skill of illustrating with examples, Skill of Reinforcement, Skill of using Black board, Skill of Achieving closure. During the orientation, student teachers were oriented by the format or steps or procedure of writing micro teaching lesson plan for each skill. After the demonstration, feedback was received for further clarification related to skill orientation during the demonstration all the student teachers were actively participated and it was formed meaningful for student teachers during the micro teaching skill practice and they clarify their doubts related to the components various skills and utilization of these components in the skill practice session. At the



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end of the skill practice peer feedback was received and suggestions were given to their further improvement.

Outcomes of the programme:

After the completion of orientation and demonstration session the student teachers,

- Teacher trainees to learned and assimilated the new teaching skills under controlled condition.
- Prospective teachers understand the significance of micro teaching in teaching learning process.
- Apply the different components of micro teaching skills application to the teaching learning process.
- Prospective teachers developed the self-confidence in teaching of actual classroom situation.
- Developed the core teaching skills for effective classroom teaching.

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REPORT OF INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME – 2022-23

The school internship program is one of the key elements of the B.Ed course. It is also called the backbone of the course. In other words, school internship program is a type of program where the aspirant practices teaching in a school.

Before commencement of 4th Semester internship school programme need to take permission from the DDPI/BEO for school allotment. Head of the internship schools and senior teachers of the school invited for orientation programme of Internship programme, the principal of the college provide detail information regarding internship programme. As per norms and guidelines of the affiliated university, student teachers orientated for internship programme. Student Teachers have an Internship Programme of 52 days in fourth semester. In the first phase students are oriented to the internship programme. They are made aware of their responsibilities and duties during the internship. In internship the student teachers visit to different types of schools namely CBSE, Navodaya Vidyalayas, Morarji Desai School and Special Schools, DIET and BEO's office are arranged. During these visits students learn the objectives and functions of these schools and offices. They also write the report of these visits.

In the second Phase the student teachers allotted to visit to internship schools for Higher Primary Schools and Secondary Schools. Schools are assigned to the students by the Institution. A meeting of the heads of the Institutions and student teacher is held prior to Internship Programme. The Head of the Institutions are oriented to the responsibilities of student teachers and schools.

Students visit their schools prior to beginning their internship and interact with the Heads of the Institutions and collect their timetable and lessons. During the internship students teach unit plan, lesson plans, conduct unit test, diagnostic test and remedial teaching classes. Students organize co-curricular activities, a day of National significance, SUPW activity, a career guidance session, an Action research projects. Students maintain on a daily basis. This helps them to become aware of their own strengths and limitations. Thus gives them an insight into the challenges faced and the cherishing experiences. With the help of these reflections, they are able to monitor their own growth. At last student teacher's preparation and presentation of the report of the Internship. The internship programme ends with the viva-voce.

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The institution has well organized internship programme as per the affiliating university syllabus of B.Ed 2 year course for 52 days, from 11-09-2023 to 10-11-2023 for 4th semester student teacher's selected 14 Higher Primary and High Schools of Bidar District for the internship programme.
