Vermi-Compost

For vermicompost production, a multitude of organic substrates can be used. In deciding for or against certain substrates, individual circumstances must be taken into account. In Our College campus has utilized the best combination of waste generated in the campus. Substrates we have successfully used in vermicompost production are.

- · Agricultural manure: eg, cow dung, chicken droppings, dung
- Kitchen waste peeling of vegetables and fruits, stale food etc.
- · Agricultural by-products: eg, leaves, harvest residues
- Renewable resources: eg, crop silage, hay, cereals, beets

Vermicomposting is a scientific method of composting using earthworms. They usually live in the soil, eating biomass and excreting it in decaying form. Rumiculture means "worm farming". Earthworms feed on organic waste material and excrete in the form of "rumicasts" rich in nitrates and minerals such as phosphorus, magnesium, calcium and potassium. These are used as fertilizers and improve soil quality. Recomposing involves two methods

Pit Method: This method is not ideal because it involves poor aeration and drainage problems. However organic matter is collected in cement pits.

Bed Method: This is an easy method of making beds of organic matter.

In our college we have mainly followed pit method for vermicompost production. Procedure

- 1. For making compost, a concrete tank can be used.
- 2. Collect the biomass and keep it in sunlight for about 8-12 days.
- 3. Prepare cow dung slurry and sprinkle it on the pile for quick decomposition.
- 4. Add a layer of soil or sand to the bottom of the tank.
- 5. Later prepared a good bed by adding partially dry leaves, decomposed cow dung and other biodegradable wastes collected from fields and kitchen.
- 6. Continue to add both chopped bio-waste and partially decomposed cow dung to the tank layer wise to a depth of around 1.0 feet.

7. After adding all the organic waste, leave the earthworm species on top of the mixture and cover the compost mixture with dry grass.



- 8. The moisture has been maintained regularly by spraying water.
- Cover the tank with a roof to prevent entry of ants, lizards, rats and etc. and to protect the compost from rainwater and direct sunlight.
- 10. Check the compost frequently to avoid overheating. Maintain proper humidity and temperature.

The major benefits of vermicomposting are:

- 1. Develops plant roots.
- 2. Improves the physical structure of the soil.
- 3. Vermicomposting increases soil fertility and water resistance.
- 4. Helps in germination, plant growth and crop yield.
- 5. Nourishes the soil with plant growth hormones like auxin, gibberellic acid, etc.


